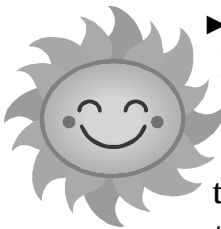


## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES...*Earn your volunteer hours!*
