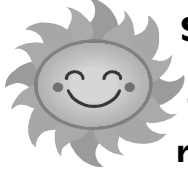

Youth Ministry Mission Trip...Four days after Hurricane Katrina devastated the gulf coast, five tradesmen borrowed a fishing boat from a friend, piled into a work truck, and drove from Chicago to Mississippi. They knew they had to help. Years later, Mississippi and Louisiana are still recovering. People are still homeless and without basic necessities. The tradesman still come down every summer to help out, except now there are thousands of teens and volunteers joining them. Project Hope & Compassion started with five men and has grown into a summer expedition supported by numerous people. From July 20-28, 20 teens and a few adults from St. Augustine parish will make a road trip to Mississippi as they attempt to do their part. The work varies greatly, and can include anything from painting a newly built house (built by other volunteers), mowing an elderly person's lawn, laying a concrete foundation for a Church or local storeowner's shop, and everything in between. The group will also attend daily Mass, pray each evening together, and strive to work with a smile as they hope to imitate Christ for the entire trip.
