The week of November 2 is *Character Counts! Week* at SAS. Below are the special activities planned for students in order to reinforce the importance of good character.

Monday: “*Creative Craft Day*” - Students will make bracelets using the colors of the six pillars of good character. (Students may wear bracelets to school this week.)

Wednesday: “*Caring Community Day*” - Students will make and assemble bag lunches, decorate bags, and create prayer cards for the homeless. Students in grades 3-6 will hear a special presentation on bullying from a guest author.

Thursday: “*Special Students Day*” - Students may dress out of uniform and wear the color(s) of the six pillars (blue, yellow, green, red, orange, purple); Students in grades K-5 will view an assembly on character education. Middle School students will have a special presentation.

Friday: “*Positively Pillar Day*” - Each class will perform a skit, song or cheer demonstrating the six pillars of good character.
